### Term 3, Week 10 Organisation

The activities during this week are a combination of formal lessons, optional tutorials and social events to further embed the metalanguage of the HSC and to foster group cohesiveness and friendship.

- Wednesday September 25: Big Day Out

This year the Year 12 Big Day Out will be held at Charlestown Square South Piazza. Students will be participating in laser tag, bowling, golf and timezone. Each student will purchase a Super Entertainment Pass (\$39 paid through the front office) which covers all of these activities and more (any activities not used on the day can be used up until December 31<sup>st</sup>). Students will make their own way to Charlestown Square for coffee and/or breakfast at 9.30am with activities commencing at 10am and finishing at approximately 1pm. Hopefully, all students can make it! An excursion note will be provided to students.

- **Thursday September 26** : Breakfast, Graduation Ceremony and Formal The highlight of the week when students, staff and parents celebrate the end of 13 years at school
- Friday September 27 is a recovery day and a well-earned rest for the students (students not required to attend). However, students may arrange tutorial lessons with their teachers during this time. The Library will also be open for student use.
