An excursion is being planned for **Year 7 English** students to visit the **Jewish Museum, Darlinghurst** on **Thursday 5th September 2019**. Students will be given a guided tour of the museum and the opportunity to listen to a Holocaust survivor, as well as viewing a performance of the play 'Hitler's Daughter' at the **Monkey Bar Theatre, near Darling Harbour**.

Educational Purpose

The purpose of the visit to the museum and viewing the play is for students to gain a deeper understanding of the context of the novels studied in class. Also viewing the museum and listening to a survivor recount their Holocaust experiences will provide an opportunity for students to gain empathy for the people and events of that time period, which will be of assistance in their monologue assessment task in Year 8.

Mode of Transport/Start and Finish Times

The students will be travelling by bus leaving school at 7.00 am and returning approximately 4:30pm.

What Students Should Bring/Uniform

Students will need to bring either lunch money or money to buy lunch.
