Excursion Letter to Parents/Caregivers

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Warners Bay High School will be conducting the annual school swimming carnival on **Friday the 14th of February 2020**. The carnival will be held at **Speers Point Swimming Pool**. The swimming carnival is a compulsory school event. The cost of entry to the swimming carnival is **\$4 per student (\$3 for parent/carer spectators) to be paid on the day to the PE staff**. All students travelling by private transport need to arrive at the pool by 9:00am.

The school has organised buses to transport students from Warners Bay High School to the pool. The buses will depart Warners Bay High School at 9:10am and will arrive at Speers Point Pool at 9:20am for roll call. Students taking the bus to the pool will need to pay **\$7** at the school office or online by Wednesday the 12th of February. (These students will also need to pay **\$4** upon the entry to the pool).

At the conclusion of the carnival, students will be dismissed from the venue at 3:00pm. Those students who travelled to the venue by the organised buses will return to school in time for the afternoon normal school buses.

Students will not be given permission to leave the carnival earlier unless they are accompanied by their parent or guardian and have organised an early leave note which needs to be submitted to the office by Wednesday 12th February.

Please note that as this is a school event, appropriate swimwear must be worn at all times.

If there are any changes due to weather, then this information will be communicated through our Skoolbag App.


Students without a permission note will not be allowed to attend.
